

**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**2018 St James Town Open Albacore Regatta**  
**September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

**1. Rules**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by Rules, as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association may also apply.
- 1.3. The Albacore class rules will also apply and will override the RRS 2017-2020 if there is a conflict. If there is a conflict between the sailing instructions and the RRS 2017-2020 then the sailing instructions will take precedence.

**2. Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1. Open to all Albacore sailors who are members of the Canadian Albacore Association, including all members of CAA-affiliated sailing clubs.
- 2.2. There will be two fleets in the regatta, “A”, and “B”. The fleets will race as one fleet, but will be scored as separate fleets.

**3. Entry Fee**

- 3.1. The entry fee of \$80.00 includes dinner for the skipper and crew. Racing only is \$55.00 per boat. Additional dinner tickets can be purchased for \$25.

**4. Schedule**

- 4.1 Registration will be online at sailtoronto.com and on Saturday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, from 0900 to 0930 at the SJTSC clubhouse.
- 4.2 Saturday Schedule

0900 – 0930	Registration and Check In
0930	Skipper’s Meeting
1045	First Warning Signal
1600	No races to start after this time (1530 if on the lake)
After Racing	Prizes, Dinner and Band

**5. Scoring**

- 5.1. The low point scoring system of appendix A will apply. If four or more races are sailed, there will be one discard.

**6. Disclaimer**

- 6.1. The Organizing Authority shall require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property of the SJTSC. The Organizing Authority, their members, employees, officers and/of agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.
