* REPORT ON ANNUAL MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 18, 1964
AT WINDERMERE, MUSKOKA

1. Officers elected for 1964/65 year

President	-	Doug Jarrett
Vice-President	-	Don Grant
Secretary-Treasurer	-	John Tinker
Past-President	-	Don Giffin

2. President, Don Giffin reported the decision of Grampian Marine, Oakville, Ontario to build fiberglass Albacores under license from Fairey Marine in England. As a result of a motion passed at the meeting a special committee has been appointed to recommend the policy the Association should adopt with respect to issuing the Association's measurement certificates. The Committee's report is to be circulated to the general membership by the end of June 1965, in order that it may be discussed with understanding at the next annual meeting.

NOTE: For the year 1965 Continental Yacht Sales and Grampian Marine are approved builders and any person purchasing or ordering a boat in 1965 from these builders may obtain a measurement certificate upon application and completion of the established measurement procedure and upon payment of the required \$5.00 fee.

3. INCREASE IN ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEES

After discussion of the financial status of the Association which after payment of the cost of producing the 1964 year book (which is about 1/5 of normal cost due to the efforts of one of our members) would show a deficit for the year, a motion was made and unanimously approved to increase the annual fee from \$2.00 to \$5.00 effective for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1965. A billing for the 1964/65 year is attached at the bottom of the last page.

4. 1965 REGATTA

The 1965 Championship Regatta will again be held at Windermere, Lake Rosseau, Muskoka, on September 17, 18 and 19, 1965.
