### REGATTA REVISIONS

Shadow Lakes Invitational - Changed to August 18th from August 11th.

Owen Sound Sailing Association Open Regatta - This was not held on July 27th at the Georgian Yacht Club but has been postponed to late in August. Contact John Tinker for details.

Toronto Sailing and Canoe Club Regatta - Lack of wind on July 20th postponed the centreboard races. Awards will be made by the club on the results of the first C.N.E. race on August 17th.

### CANADIAN ALBACORE CHAMPIONSHIP

A reminder to keep Sept. 13th-15th open for the 8th annual championship, again being held at Cleavelands House. This year will follow last year's innovation of three classes of boats. A - those with racing skill. B - those with some racing experience. C - novices or those with little racing experience and new boat-owners. Remember association membership and a valid certificate are essential to enter. Forms will be mailed out in August.

### NORTH AMERICAN ALBACORE CHAMPIONSHIP

Charles Loutrel Jr. of the Potomac River Sailing Club won the series, winning one race and posting low scores in three others. He was closely followed by Dr. Jack Langmaid of Shadow Lakes Sailing Club. Royal Hamilton Yacht Club as host club provided first class facilities, excellent organization and the wind co-operated by providing a variety of conditions to test everyone's skills. In fact the shifty conditions contributed to wide difference in positions in the various races. No one won more than one race and many leading skippers finished at least one race near the tail end of the fleet.

The balance of the top honours were again divided between Canadian and U.S. skippers. Larry Cond, now of the TS & CC, finished third. John Whitton of Muskegon, Mich. was fourth and Rick Solomon, a leading junior skipper from Ashbridges Bay Yacht Club was fifth over-all. Don Grant last year's winner was sixth.
