NOTICE OF RACECANADIAN ALBACORE ASSOCIATION1974 JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

1. LOCATION: To be sailed on Lake Muskoka, Ontario, July 27th and 28th, 1974, under the auspices of the Canadian Albacore Association and hosted by the South Muskoka Sailing Club, Walkers Point Road, Highway 69.
2. OBJECT: To determine the Canadian Albacore Junior Sailing Champion.
3. RULES: The Championship will be sailed under the rules of the International Yacht Racing Union as adopted by the Canadian Yachting Association and the rules of the Canadian Albacore Association.
4. YACHTS:
 - a) All yachts must have a valid current Canadian Albacore Association measurement certificate or equivalent. Measurement certificate must be presented at the time of registration. All yachts on which changes have been made affecting measurement rules should have the changes checked and certified by a Measurer.
 - b) All yachts must show satisfactory evidence that they comply with buoyancy requirements of the Canadian Albacore Association for the current year, 1974.
 - c) Each yacht competing must carry a vest type or government approved life preserver for each occupant, a bailer firmly attached, a paddle and a strong painter not less than 20 feet, attached to the bow.
5. ELIGIBILITY: The Canadian Albacore Association Junior Championship is open to all yachts whose helmsmen meet the membership requirements outlined below and whose helmsmen and crew have not achieved their 20th (twentyieth) birthday as of December 31, 1974.

If a yacht starts the series with two persons it must continue with two persons throughout the series. Similarly, if a yacht starts with three persons it must continue with three persons throughout the series. The helmsman must be a paid-up members of the C.A.A. or U.S.A.A., a member of the immediate family of such a paid-up member, or an associate member of either Association and must be a regular user of an Albacore. (The above therefore means that a person enrolled in a Junior Sailing Program utilising Albacores but who is not a member of the C.A.A. or U.S.A.A. or a member of an immediate family of such a member would be eligible by becoming an Associate member).

A helmsman may not be changed during any race. There is no restriction on changing helmsmen from race to race. The helmsman named in the application form must be in the boat, however, in all races.

Crew changes will be allowed if application is made therefore to the Race Committee, in writing, prior to the start of the series, specifying the name and weight of the crews concerned, and the dates on which the crews concerned are to sail. No crew change will be permitted on the same day as the race unless the Race Committee is satisfied that

the weight of the substitute crew will not give the applicant an advantage considering the forecast winds.

6. ENTRIES: All entries along with an entry fee of \$27.50, Skipper and one crew; \$41.25 Skipper and two crew, shall be mailed by July 1st, and not later than July 12th, to Mrs. L. Hart, R. R. 2, Gravenhurst, Ontario. Cheque to be made payable to South Muskoka Sailing Club. A late entry charge of \$5.00 will be made for entries received after July 15, 1974.
7. TROPHIES AND PRIZES: The Poyntz Trophy will be awarded to the helmsman who wins the Canadian Albacore Association Junior Championship.

Trophies will be awarded to the helmsman and crew of each of the first three yachts in each class.

Trophies will be awarded to the helmsman and crew of the first three yachts in the age groupings of those who have achieved their 17th but not their 20th birthday as of December 31st, 1974.

Trophies will be awarded to the helmsman and crew of the first three yachts in the age grouping of those who have achieved their 14th but not their 17th birthday as of December 31st, 1974.

Trophies will be awarded to the helmsman and crew of the first three yachts in the age grouping of those who have not achieved their 14th birthday as of December 31st, 1974.

8. REGISTRATION: Registration will be from 7:00 P.M. to 9:30 P.M. on Friday July 26th and from 8:00 A.M. to 10:30 A.M. on Saturday, July 27th, 1974, at W. Pratt's dock, Walkers Point, Muskoka. (See Map attached).

Sailing instructions, meal tickets, billeting details and other information will be available upon registration.

9. SKIPPERS MEETING: A skipper and crew meeting will be held at 10:30 A.M., July 27th, 1974 at the Registration area.
10. FOOD, LODGING, ENTERTAINMENT & TRANSPORTATION: All visiting contestants who have registered by July 15th, 1974 will be billeted on Friday night if desired, and Saturday night, and given breakfast and driven to their boats by members and friends of the South Muskoka Sailing Club.

Lunches will be provided for noon meals for all contestants on both Saturday and Sunday, July 27th and 28th. The Saturday night dinner will be followed by a Teen Party. (Please note that no lunches will be available to families or friends of contestants, nor are there any restaurants at the site of the Championship. Please arrange to bring lunches or visit the nearest eating places in Gravenhurst or Bala, Ontario.

Trophies and prizes will be presented following lunch after the last race on Sunday.

11. YACHT LAUNCHING AND STORAGE: All yachts arriving by trailer should be launched at W. Pratt's dock, launching help will be provided. A supervised area for trailer storage and boat storage will be provided.

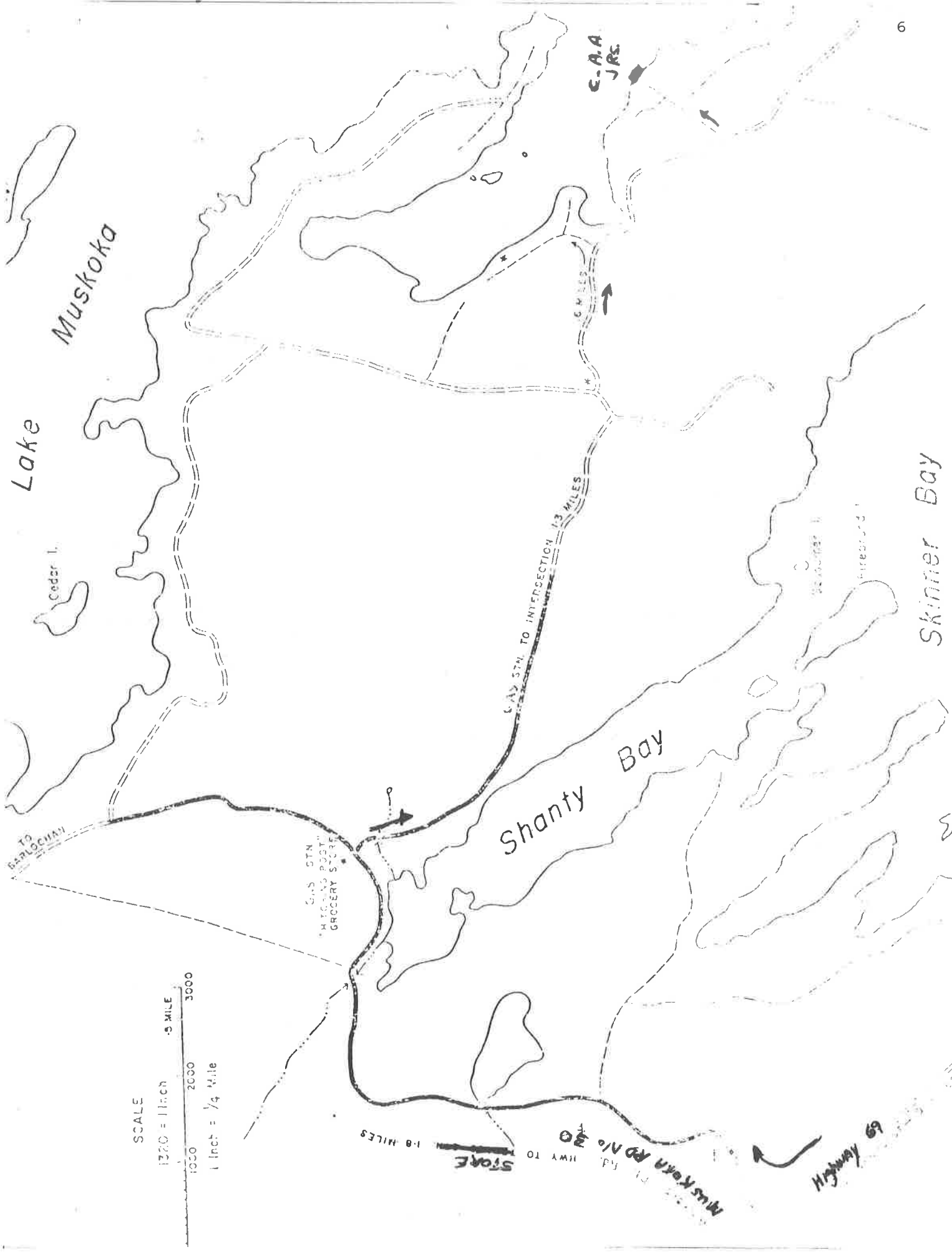
